Spacious luxury pine lodges, sleeping between two and six. Your Dog viewed Juniper lodge which has entry via a decked area and then through the well-equipped kitchen/diner.

Dogs are allowed in 13 of the 15 lodges, in any of the rooms but not on the beds or furniture. With a contemporary design, leather sofas are easy to wipe off in the case of accidental brushes and there are wooden/tiled floors throughout. Juniper lodge features a large range cooker so it's as easy to dine in as it is to go out to any of the local dog-friendly eateries.

Each lodge also contains information and lists of walks and dog-friendly attractions. The site itself is well laid out to maximise privacy between lodges while offering a closeness to the surrounding woodland. Parking is outside each lodge. Walks around the site are straight from the door, but not off lead as guests are asked to keep dogs under close control until they reach the meadow.

It's preferred that dogs are not left alone in the lodges but can be crated for short periods. Dog sitters are available locally.

All the lodges feature many mod cons and some have their own hot tubs!

Ox Pasture Hall



A little luxury in the bedrooms.

The Best Western Ox Pasture Hall hotel, situated just on the edge of the busy seaside resort of Scarborough is very dog-friendly. The chic country hotel neighbours Raincliffe Woods, which leads directly to the Forge Valley and then on to the North York Moors.

Dogs are allowed throughout the public areas of the hotel, apart from the formal dining room and guests can sample whichever menu they prefer in the lounge, bar or brasserie. Well-behaved dogs may be left for short periods in the bedrooms while guests dine.

The courtyard bedrooms, many with stunning views

across open countryside, are ideal for dogs as they are ground floor level and offer access directly out into the 17-acres provided for guests to enjoy. Dogs can be off lead once away from the hotel and clear of the two ponds. Walks have had all stiles removed. Staff are able to provide maps, as well as old towels, bowls etc. Other off site walks are located down the hotel's drive, across the road and into Raincliffe Woods.

Guests also have access to the laundry room, which can be used as a wet room for dog cleaning.
