### **RICHMOND TOWN CENTRE**

1. Turn right out of Flowery Dell.
2. At the end of the lane turn left.
3. Take the second right turning after the bridge.
4. Follow the road turning right up the steep hill.
5. Parking in on the cobbled area in Richmond Centre is currently free you just need to put a blue disc in your windscreen with arrival time (blue disc available free from reception or local shops). Please note there are pay and display car parks around the outskirts of the town

**Reeth** – Once the capital of the local lead mining industry, Reeth is now a popular place with visitors to the Dales and has many tea rooms and craft shops, mainly based around the large village green. Try the Garden House Pottery on the corner of the green which sells home-made pottery and the popular Damson Cheese. The Overton House Café is worth trying. [www.reeth.org](http://www.reeth.org)

**Hawes** – This unique market town is famous for its chocolate box, picture postcard appeal, but it is also home to some of the most delicious local cheese (made famous by Wallace and Gromit), and the ancient art of ropemaking. There is a popular market, held every Tuesday.

**Aysgarth** – Near the village of Aysgarth, the River Ure tumbles over a series of limestone steps which are known as Aysgarth Falls. Although not particularly high, the waterfalls are a well-known beauty spot and were made even more famous when they featured in Robin Hood - Prince of Thieves starring Kevin Costner.
